



HOUSING RULES, REGULATIONS, AND RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. Billeting players are guests of the housing family, and as such are expected to respect the rules and order of the family with which they are staying.**
- 2. ABSOLUTLY NO ALCOHOL or ILLEGAL DRUG** may be brought into the billeting home or supplied by a billet for a player. It is against the law and team policy for our players to consume alcohol and partake in drugs.
- 3. Players may not stay at a billeting home other than their own or a hotel UNLESS given explicit permission to do so by the coaching staff.**
- 4. If a player is going to be late for, or miss a planned meal with his billeting family, the player must notify the family by the beginning of practice.**
- 5. Billeting families are expected to provide the player with access to a balanced diet at reasonable hours.**
- 6. Players must obey team-set curfews. While we will call to check curfews, housing families must feel free to communicate any problems directly with the coaching staff or housing coordinators.**
- 7. Players may NOT use the billeting family's home phone without express permission of the family. Players must have calling cards or their own cell phone for their private use.**
- 8. Players may NOT use any vehicle owned by the housing family (car, motorcycle, truck, bicycle) under any circumstance.**
- 9. Housing families must understand that there may be dates after expended travel that the players arrive home from a trip in the early morning. Your understanding is appreciated under these circumstances.**
- 10. Players and billeting families should construct a time framed access to the home computer. Players are expected to refrain from accessing any sites the housing family finds inappropriate.**
- 11. All issues regarding billets must be brought to the housing coordinators attention.**
